Invasive species native to North America. **Widespread** in the wild in Belgium

Found in **wetlands** and along **waterways**



Emerged plant that can grow to heights of 80 cm

Ovate or suborbicular coarsely toothed leaves, strongly ribbed




Can form **dense stands**

Mimulus moschatus Hairy plant. No spot on the flowers
